Registration Step 1

Upon receipt of the registration, you will receive an email for **confirmation of receipt**. By registering, you accept the terms and conditions of participation for this workshop and the payment terms. Registrations are possible at any time.

Registration Step 2

Upon receipt of the registration, the workshop organizer will generally accept the registration. If the number of participants for a particular instrument or vocal group is too high, you will be notified immediately by email. In exceptional cases, the organizer will decide in consultation with the professional coaches. In all cases, **registration confirmation or rejection** will be sent via email.

Admission after payment of the workshop fee

In October of the previous year, participants will receive an email with a request to transfer the course fee to the bank account specified in the email. Please note: JazzWorkshop, last name, first name. If the participation fee is not paid within the next four weeks, the workshop organizer reserves the right to offer the course place to someone else.

Withdrawal from Course Registration

Withdrawal from course registration should be sent via email. The following fees will be charged for withdrawals: before October 1 of the previous year: full refund of the participation fee; from October 1 of the previous year: €50 fee; from November 1 of the previous year: €100 fee; from December 1 of the previous year: €200 fee; from January 1 of the workshop year: €300 fee; from February 1 of the workshop year: full participation fee.
